

**MINUTES OF THE
TOPTON BOROUGH COUNCIL
Monday November 23rd, 2020**

Members of the Tipton Borough Council met on Monday November 23rd, 2020 at 7:00 P.M virtually via Zoom. The meeting was called to order by Council President Mr. Bower with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call was taken and the following members were present Mayor Biltcliff, Ms. Kunkel, Ms. Lorah, Mr. Bower, Mr. Stauffer, Mr. Beck, and Mrs. Moll. Mr. Jost was absent.

HEARING OF VISITORS

Ms. Carol Cook asked if there was a contingency fund to cover additional cost. Mr. Bower noted there is no fund and explained the Borough would monitor the budget for the project as it progresses and possibly reduce budget items to reduce overall cost of the project.

BOROUGH MANAGER

Borough Manager Stacy Milo discussed with council the proposed paid half days for all employees on the afternoons of Wednesday, November 25th, Thursday, December 24th, and Thursday, December 31st. Mr. Stauffer made a motion to grant this proposal for the above noted paid half days. Ms. Lorah seconded this motion passing unanimously.

TASA PROJECT DISCUSSION

Council met to discuss the three options presented by Barry Isett & Associates regarding the TASA project. After further discussion Ms. Lorah made a motion to proceed with Option C with the revision of retaining the third bridge, also to authorize the usage of the park project loan proceeds for amounts owed by The Borough of Tipton. Ms. Kunkel seconded this motion passing unanimously.
