

**MINUTES OF THE

Monday April 26<sup>th</sup>, 2021**

Members of the Tipton Borough Council met on Monday, April 26<sup>th</sup>, 2021 at 7:00 P.M. for a second scheduled monthly meeting virtually via Zoom. The meeting was called to order by Council President Mr. Bower with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call was taken and the following members were present Mayor Biltcliff, Ms. Kunkel, Ms. Lorah, Mr. Bower, Mr. Beck, Mr. Stauffer, Mrs. Moll and Mr. Polinsky. No visitors were in attendance.

**MAYOR'S REPORT**

**COMMITTEE REPORTS**

**Personnel Committee – (Mrs. Moll)**

Borough council discussed the addition of a full time public works employee. After further discussion, Ms. Lorah made a motion to move forward with this position at a rate of no less than \$17.75 an hour. Mrs. Moll seconded this motion passing unanimously.

Mr. Stauffer made a motion to approve borough manager to advertise this new position.

Mr. Polinsky seconded this motion passing unanimously.

**Parks & Recreation Committee – (Ms. Lorah)**

Ms. Lorah discussed lifeguard interviews to date, including 10 interviews that were held on Monday April 26<sup>th</sup>, 2021. Mrs. Moll made a motion to hire the 10 lifeguards that were interviewed on Monday April 26<sup>th</sup>, 2021. Mr. Polinsky seconded this motion passing unanimously.

Ms. Lorah discussed the damaged restroom doors at the baseball field and the replacement of the doors. The borough is also renting portable bathrooms for the baseball field until the doors and locks can be replaced.

Ms. Lorah discussed the updated quote for the dog park fence. Also Ms. Lorah discussed the donations received to date are \$5,300.00. After further discussion council made a decision to hold off on dog park fence until more donations are received and prices possibly decrease.
