**2020 OPERATIONAL BUDGET**

Mr. Dolny presented council with first draft of the 2020 operational budget for their review. Highlights and discussion points as follows:

- Purchases outstanding for 2019 are as follows: Small gator or ATV, upgrades of laptop and pad, continued work on waste water infrastructure project.
- Possible 1mil tax increase relating to ambulance service and part time police force
- Completion of playground, basketball court, new pavilion as first full phase of the master park plan
- Completion of pool and recreation center feasibility study
- Possible Occupancy permit/Inspection program for rentals
- New 550 Ford Dump through 902 Grant
- Phase 2 of the Toad creek rehabilitation
- Possible road projects
