

**MINUTES OF THE  
TOPTON BOROUGH COUNCIL  
Monday October 25<sup>th</sup>, 2021**

Members of the Tipton Borough Council met on Monday October 25, 2020 at 7:00 P.M. for a special workshop to discuss the proposed 2022 budget. The meeting was called to order by Council President Mr. Bower with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call was taken and the following members were present Mayor Biltcliff, Ms. Kunkel, Ms. Lorah, Mr. Bower, Mr. Stauffer, Mr. Beck, Mr. Polinsky and Mrs. Moll. Visitors were also in attendance.

**2022 OPERATIONAL BUDGET**

Ms. Stacy Milo presented council a draft of the proposed 2022 operational budget for their review. Highlights and discussion points are as follows:

- Revenues to be affected by recent pandemic and resulting economy
- Financial Compliance = Segregation of Duties
- Current Loans are: Sewer Improvements, Public Works Truck, Park Improvements, and Purchase of W. Weis Street property
- Toad Creek Phase II Improvements – Continuing Project is Almost Complete
- Fleetwood Police – propose an 0% increase
- Pool: Short-Term and Long-Term Maintenance Issues Have Led to Lack of 2022 Season
- Capital Planning for Infrastructure Improvements: Streets and Alleys
- Future Additional Sources of Water

**Multi-Municipal Purchase**

Mr. Polinsky made a motion to move to enter into an intermunicipal agreement and purchase of a paver in the amount of \$76,094.00, which is one-fourth of the total purchase price of \$304,376.00. Mr. Beck seconded this motion passing unanimously.
