SNOW REMOVAL

The Borough's main priority once a snow emergency is declared, will be to clear the snow emergency routes, followed by other streets second, and lastly alleys. After roads are made passable, streets will then be cleared curb to curb. Depending on the severity of the storm, this process may take a few days.

Remember that cars **must** be removed from Snow Emergency Routes or they will be towed at the owner's expense.

- Pay at the office with cash, check, or with a card. (There is no fee to pay with a card in the office.)
- Pay with a check in the drop box in the office door or by mail.

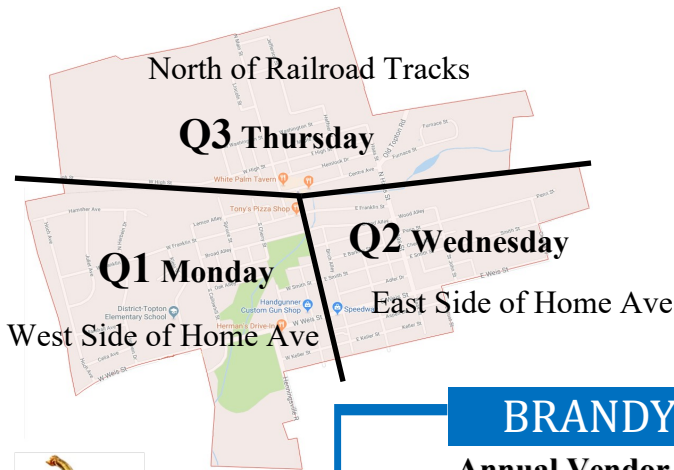

LEAF COLLECTION (Weather Permitting)

Begins: **Monday, October 23rd** Ends: **Wednesday, November 22nd**

The Public Works crew will follow a specific route throughout the leaf collection period. Leaves will not be permitted to be placed in the street after the final day of leaf collection.



Residents should...

- Rake leaves into the street along the curb line the night prior to the scheduled pick up without blocking or clogging storm drains.
- Park vehicles away from piled leaves.

The Borough **will not pick up leaves** if brush, sticks, twigs, grass or animal waste are included in the piles.
