

***MINUTES OF THE
Borough of Topton Municipal Authority
Monday, January 9th, 2023***

Members of the Borough of Topton Municipal Authority met on Monday, January 9, 2023 at 6:30 P.M. for an advertised scheduled public meeting at the Borough Hall, 205 South Callowhill Street, Topton, PA 19562. The meeting was called to order by Mr. Sprankle with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call was taken and the following members were present: Mr. Sprankle, Mr. Reppert, Mr. Meitzler, Attorney Joan London, Borough Council Solicitor from Kozloff Stoudt Attorneys, and Borough Manager Stacy Milo.

Mr. Meitzler made a motion to approve the minutes from September 9, 2021. Mr. Reppert seconded this motion passing unanimously.

Mr. Reppert nominated Mr. Sprankle as chairperson for Municipal Authority for 2023. Mr. Meitzler seconded this motion passing unanimously.

Mr. Meitzler made a motion to appoint Ms. Milo to be secretary for the Municipal Authority. Mr. Reppert seconded this motion passing unanimously.

Mr. Reppert made a motion to accept the resignation of Mr. Andrew Kelhart. Mr. Meitzler seconded this motion passing unanimously.

Mr. Sprankle and Mr. Reppert welcomed Mr. Meitzler as a new member of the Authority.

Mr. Reppert made a motion to place Resolution No. 2023-1 on the floor for discussion. Mr. Meitzler seconded this motion passing unanimously. The Municipal Authority members briefly reviewed the resolution on the floor, which raises water and sewer rates for residential, commercial, and industrial customers. Mr. Reppert made a motion to adopt Resolution No. 2023-1. Mr. Meitzler seconded this motion passing unanimously.

Ms. London discussed the Borough Council's discussions with Longswamp Township regarding a Memorandum of Understanding involving services offered to Township properties by Topton.

Borough Manager Ms. Stacy Milo informed the Municipal Authority that the Borough Council accepted the Source Water Protection Plan and the program is underway.

Ms. London continued to discuss siting a secondary drinking water well at the Topton Fire Company property for compliance as well as for fire protection.

Ms. Milo noted that Borough of Topton employee, Randy Sicher, received his water treatment plant operator certification.
